# Discovery Group Facilitator Guide



1. How did you do with last week's "I will" and sharing? With whom did you share last week's lesson? How did you put into practice what you learned from last week's lesson?



2. What are you thankful for this week?



3. What is stressing you out lately?



4. Do you have a need or know anyone with a need that this group can meet?

**READ THE PASSAGE** (For the first few sessions provide handouts of the selected Scripture passage. Read the passage aloud <u>twice</u> in one or two different modern versions; for example, NIV, NIRV, NKJV, NET. Paraphrased translations like The Message can be so eloquent that once it is read, there is little improvement to find. This can shut down the discussion because no one can add anything to what has been written.)



### 5. What is God saying in this passage?

- - What did you like about this passage?
  - Did anything bother you? Why?
- What is God saying to you? .....
  What does this passage tell you about God?
  - What does this passage tell you about humankind?
  - What does this passage tell you about the life God desires for you?



- 6. If this is God speaking, what does this mean about who you are and what are you personally going to do about it? (It helps to be specific.)
  - If you believe this passage is from God, what is He trying to tell you?
  - Develop a statement that will put into practice what you learned from this passage.

NOTE: Take two minutes in silence to let each person reflect. Than ask someone to share what they have developed. Make sure someone records the "I will" statements for you to ask them next week.



- 7. With whom will you share what you learned this week? (Share with at least one person preferably who is not in a relationship with God and preferably someone already in your relational network.)
  - How will we follow-up on the needs we agreed to help meet in Question 4?
  - Where are we meeting next week?
  - Let's pray.
